Conclusions and Comments

- DPH on track to end year within budget
- No supplemental appropriations anticipated
- Significant variances from budgets are driven by relationship between revenues and transfers out
 - Reduced intergovernmental transfers under new waiver result in lower revenues,
 offset by savings in transfers out for non-federal share
 - \$18 million budget authority to transfer surplus ZSFG revenues to EHR project; revenues are not forecast to be achieved, results in revenues below budget equally offset by savings in transfers out to project
- Modes CY impact of new 1115 Waiver on financial statements, but decline forecast for future budgets as DSH reductions take effect
